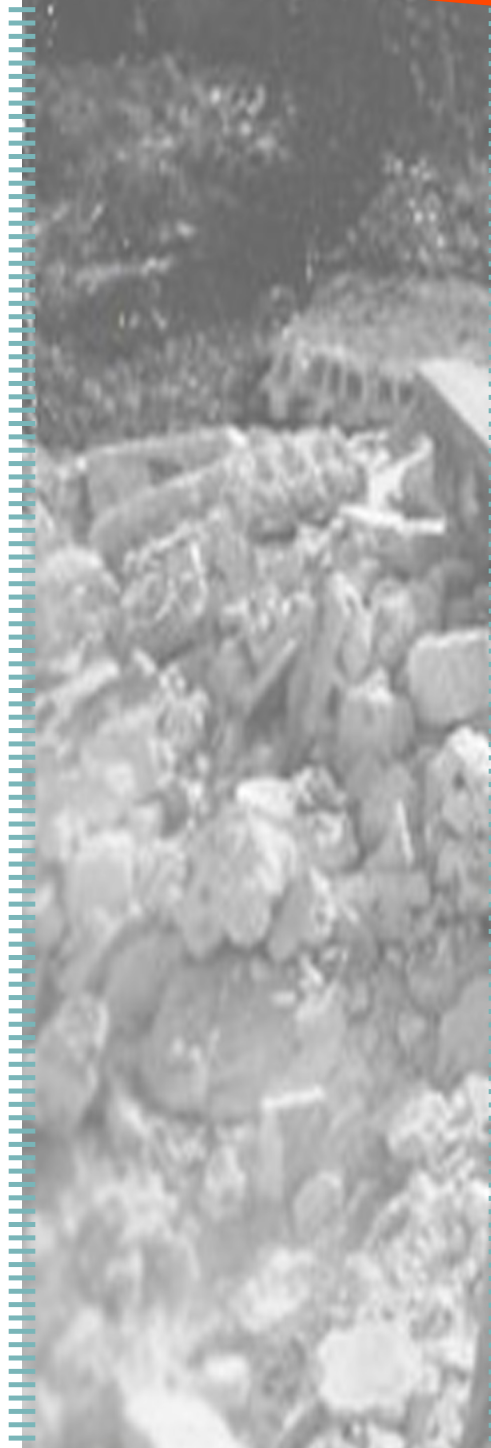

RUBBLE REMOVAL TO AID RECONSTRUCTION

Among the massive challenges facing rebuilding efforts in Haiti is the seemingly endless amount of rubble left in the earthquake's wake. Over a year after the devastating blow, thousands of homes, businesses, schools and churches lie in ruins, mounds of collapsed concrete slabs that remain a formidable barrier to the future.

Many of the issues that plague Haiti's rebirth are complex, yet rubble removal is not. That is, if the right equipment is in place and skilled teams are on the scene. While it takes a dozen workers armed with hammers months to clear one two-story home, a heavy equipment team using an excavator and a dump truck can accomplish the same task in one day. One month vs. one day. Yet, there are few such heavy equipment teams working in Haiti as we speak. Until the rubble is gone, rebuilding cannot begin.

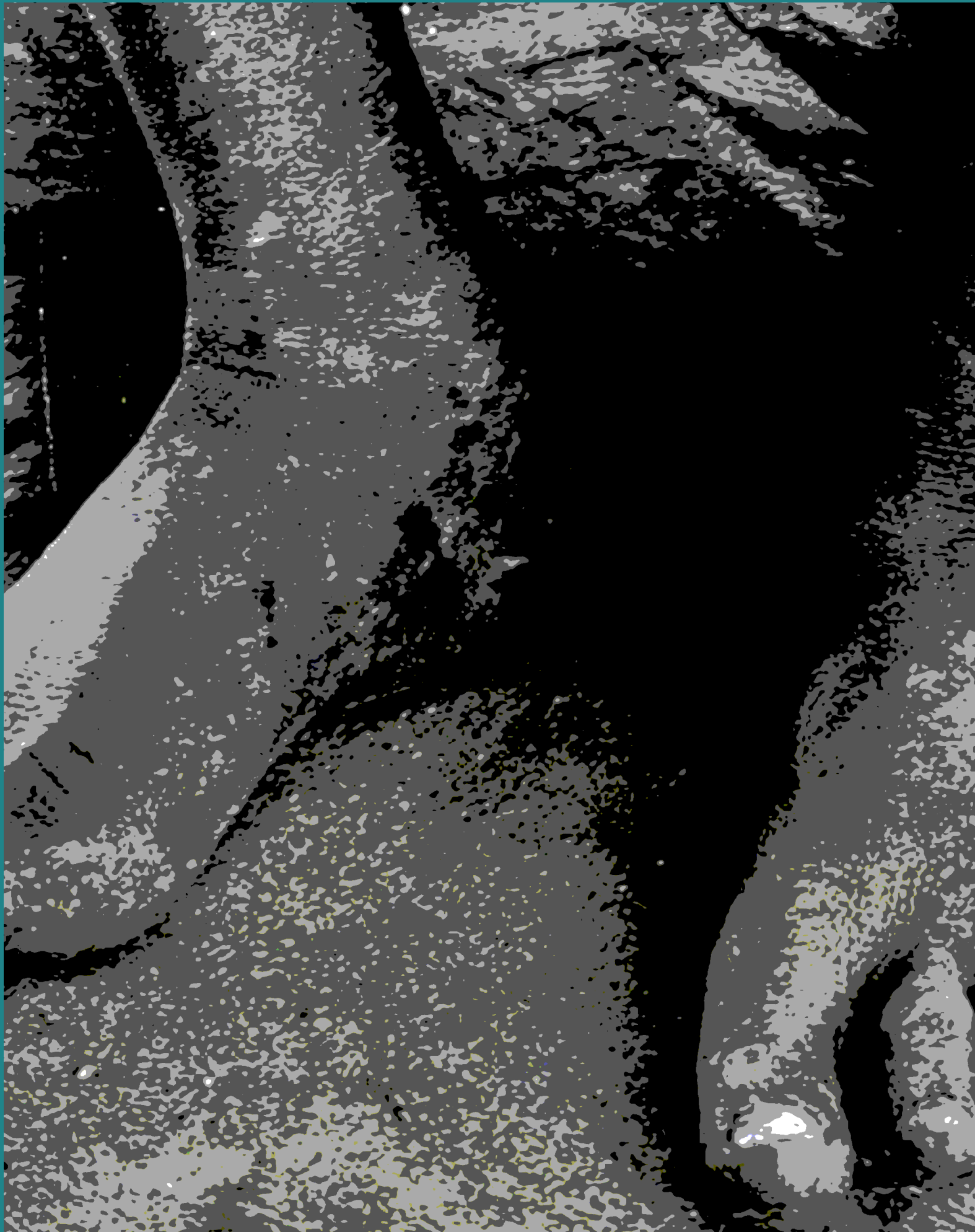

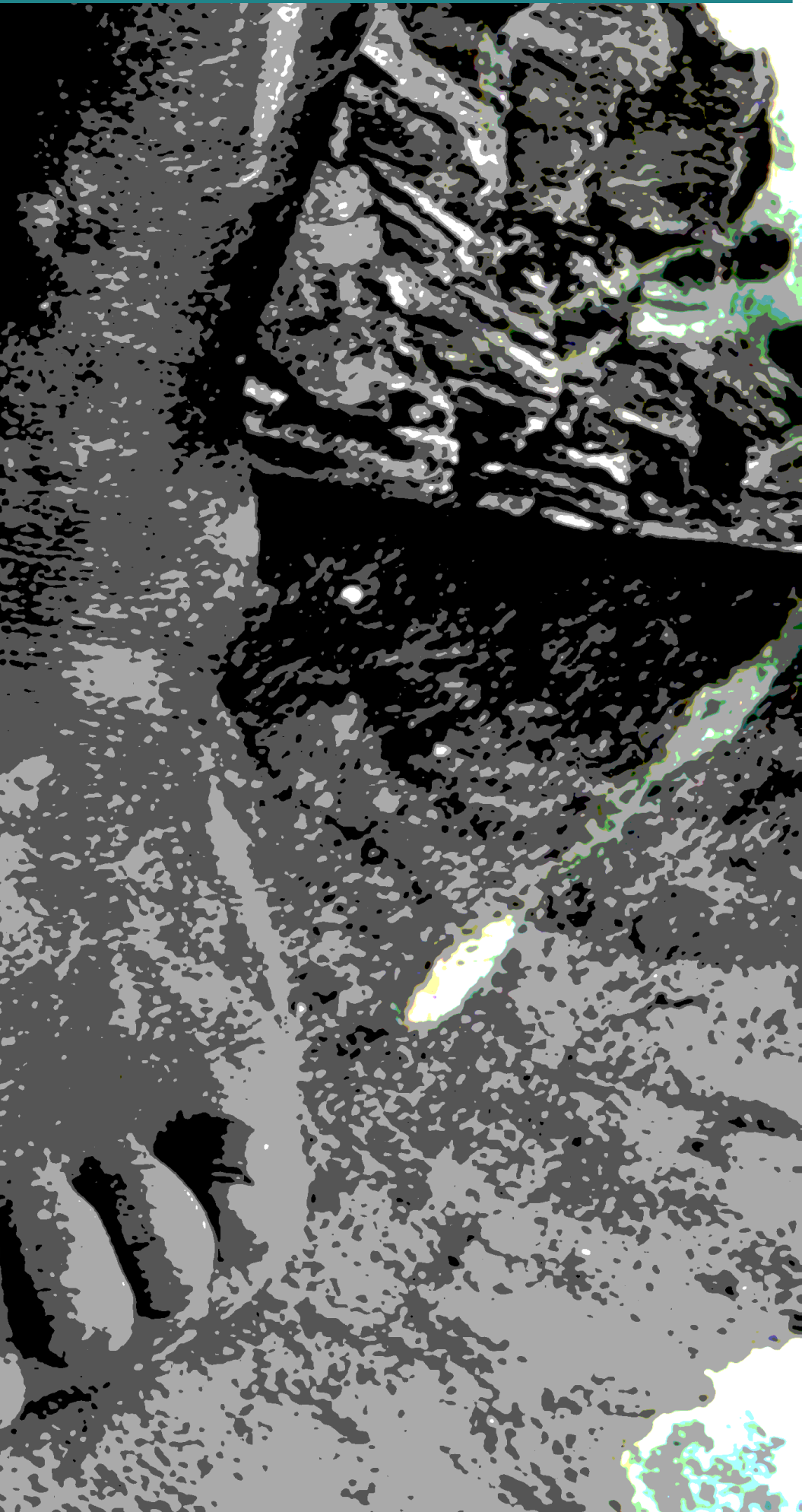

FREEDOM FOR GIRLS IN INDIA

Many girls in India are enslaved in the sex trade by default: They are born into the brothel. For 95% of girls born into these circumstances, the only option is to become enslaved in the sex trade. Our partner rescues these girls from the entrapment, takes them in and cares for them by providing a home, education, physical needs and spiritual direction. Together we can break the generational cycle of exploitation, as we rescue, care and protect each child — for life.

Millions of women and children are trapped in sex trafficking and prostitution throughout the world. In Nepal, there is an alarming number of children and young women being trafficked for commercial sexual exploitation every day into India's brothels. In response, the Not For Sale Campaign has established Border Outposts that consist of surveillance teams, safe houses, and monitoring programs that survey the transit buses with the help of local police to help identify criminals smuggling victims across Nepal's border. Last year alone these outposts rescued nearly 2,000 girls from the sex trade! Currently only 8 of Nepal's 24 border crossings are being monitored. At Passion 2010 we aim to raise funds to establish a new border outpost for \$25,000 and help stop trafficking before it starts!
